1. WELCOME AND REFRESHMENTS

3. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Guest Speakers:

Bernadette Hornell from Marketing Department showcased four different designs for the Youth Festival Flyers. Research shows that Sonic Youth was a band from many years ago and therefore to avoid any association with the band the name of the Youth Festival was decided on Sonic Fest. The Stirling Youth Advisory Council expressed that they would like to have a consistent name for future Youth Festivals and requested that this be Sonic Fest. From the four designs the City of Stirling Youth Advisory Council expressed that they liked the flyer with the blue background, however would like the head pictured on the flyer either to be closed or to be withdrawn from the flyer. The City of Stirling Youth Advisory Council requested that the font of "Sonic" be modified to be in line and not jumbled. It was suggested that the Stirling Youth Advisory Council logo be placed on the flyer. A request was made for the white Stirling Youth Advisory Council logo with black borders. Bernadette confirmed that the second draft of the Youth Festival flyer would be available for viewing at the next Youth Advisory Council meeting.

4.1 Wind up Event – All members of the Stirling Youth Advisory Council enjoyed themselves. The night was a great success thanks to the great food, music and company. Needs to be followed up with Heidi from road safety or Kendra from Community Safety. If we have trouble Councillor Michael has said he will give road safety a call. All members to come up with other interactive ideas for Youth Festival as well as ideas of items that can be placed in a show bag. A suggestion was made that once the flyers are finalized that as a marketing technique the flyers to be given out to high schools in the City of Stirling area.

A display has been set up to bring along to the schools along with Youth Surveys that will be randomly allocated to students. Elizabeth, Byron, Adam and Jenita have shown interest in coming along to talk to students about their Youth Advisory Council experience.
