

Written Planning Advice

What information can I ask the City for advice on?

The specific application and/or interpretation of applying a piece of the City's local planning framework or for any other matter than cannot be addressed through general advice, pre-development advice or deemed-to-comply checks.

What information will not be provided through written planning advice?

Examples of information the City is unable to provide the following information through the written planning advice process include:

- Specific advice on proposed variations for a development that has not been formally lodged with the City and if a particular variation would be supported by the City;
- If an aspect of a proposal complies with the R-Code or Policy requirements.

These matters can only be dealt with via the development application process.
