### ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1986 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (NOISE) REGULATIONS 1997

#### NOTICE OF VENUE APPROVAL—SCARBOROUGH BEACH RESERVE

### BUSH FIRES ACT 1954 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995

#### *City of Wanneroo*

#### BUSH FIRE BRIGADES AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2025

Under the powers conferred by the *Bush Fires Act 1954* and under all other powers enabling it, the Council of the *City of Wanneroo* resolved on 25 March 2025 to make the following local law.

#### 1. Citation

This local law may be cited as the *City of Wanneroo Bush Fire Brigades Amendment Local Law 2025*.

#### 2. Commencement

This local law comes into operation 14 days after the day on which it is published in the *Government Gazette*.

#### 3. Principal local law

**5. Clause 5.3 amended**

- (a) In subclause (4)(a) remove the words “Bush Fire Brigade Officer” and replace with “Elected Officer”.
