The City is delivering a major upgrade to the playground on the western side of Carine Regional Open Space as part of the Carine Community Parkland Upgrade project. The upgrade will include new playground equipment, furniture, shelters, sporting facilities (basketball and netball) and public artwork. The upgrade is expected to be completed by October 2026.

The City recently finished a CCTV upgrade at Stirling Leisure – Karrinyup, which involved replacing 10 existing cameras with new digital models and upgrading the system to allow remote access for improved efficiency.

Our playground renewal program ensures City playgrounds are fun, safe, compliant with Australian standards and support our Public Open Space Exercise Equipment Policy. Renewals have been completed at Alvaston Ashover Ballidon Reserve and Excalibur Guinevere Reserve in Carine.



Alvaston Ashover Ballidon Reserve also received a vibrant new mural, *Protect the Little Guys*, by Lynzie Bremner with input from local students, supported by our Community Grants Program.



Street tree planting is coming soon to Carine, Balcatta and Stirling. Each year, the City plants around 7,000 new trees across street verges, reserves and natural areas through a range of planting programs.

Looking for a way to get your children into the kitchen to start cooking at home? The Mini Chef term programs at Stirling Leisure – Hamersley are a great way for children to learn basic cooking skills and kitchen safety. Suitable for children aged 6-12 years, the five-week terms run from 3.45pm – 5.00pm on Thursdays.
