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FAUNA PROTECTED BUFFER ZONE:

A fauna protected buffer zone is an area extending 200 metres from the boundary of a Cat Prohibited Area.

To check if your property is within a fauna protected buffer zone, call the City of Stirling on 9205 8555 or check the website www.stirling.wa.gov.au

To protect native species within the City, cats found in prohibited areas may be trapped and impounded and subsequently euthanised with owners liable for penalties.

Owners of cats wearing a name tag and collar or which have a microchip implanted will be notified to allow them to reclaim their cat.

CAT PROHIBITED AREAS

A cat prohibited area is a bushland or wetland area where cats are totally prohibited.
