The subsidy relates only to the first crossover to service the property. The crossover installation must comply with the City's Crossover Guidelines and Technical Specifications. A copy of materials delivery docket(s) and/or invoice(s) indicating the type of material and quantity used must be provided as evidence to support all subsidy applications. Approved payments will be calculated based on the length of the crossover, presence of splays (wings) and the City's current subsidy rates. The subsidy must be applied for within 12 months of the crossover installation. Subsidy payments will be made by cheque directly to the property owner(s) as noted on this form. |
