## Objective

This policy ensures a minimum standard of communication and consultation with owners and residents within the City in relation to proposed new parking restrictions, or alterations to existing parking restrictions.

## Scope

This policy applies:

- Parking control (regulatory) signage;
- Pavement markings associated with parking controls; and
- Information and directional signage associated with parking, installed outside of the road reserve;

applicable to roads and thoroughfares under the care, control and management of the City of Stirling.

## Policy

All owners or residents likely to be affected by proposed new parking restrictions, or alterations to existing parking restrictions, shall be contacted for comment on the proposal, and their comments shall be included in the report if and when the matter is submitted for final Council resolution.

## Definitions

**Parking control signage** means signage and pavement markings, in accordance with Australian Standard AS 1742.11.

**Information and directional signage associated with parking** means signage installed outside of the road reserve, designed in accordance with the City of Stirling Style guide.
